

- 2. Peter Kaminski, 103 Coe Road, Wolcott, came forward and stated that although he is a member of the Wolcott Volunteer Ambulance Association, he is not speaking solely in support of its budget. He began by thanking the Town Council Members who have the unenviable task of trying to provide taxpayers with the same level of services while not raising taxes. A summary of his comments is as follows:
 - He is a taxpayer in the Town of Wolcott; everyone can agree that expenses are through the roof (e.g., food, electricity, fuel, materials, etc.)
 - He is the father of seven children, three of which are currently working their way through the Wolcott Public School system
 - The educators and administrators of the Wolcott Public School system are among the best in the State
 - Wolcott's first responders, (i.e., Fire, Police, Ambulance & Public Works) are the best he has ever worked
 - He has worked in EMS in other states and there is no comparison as to the level of service, dedication, and professionalism that he has experienced in the Town of Wolcott
 - Wolcott has the best ambulance service that he has seen bar none; the Ambulance employees, and the Fire, Police, and Public Works staff are teamed with dedicated experienced members, who work together seamlessly, many times in the worst weather
 - Lastly, he expressed that although nobody wants their taxes raised, he is willing to pay more to continue to receive the outstanding services that the town provides

At this time, Chairman Wisler inquired several more times if anyone else would like to come forward, at which time there were no further comments.
