SEWER PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

(Requests for main extensions must be approved by the Sewer and Water Commission.)

1. Contractor must submit plot plan showing location of well and septic.
2. Contractor must present his current applicable St of CT license.

3. Contractor must submit an original Certificate of Insurance.
4. Contractor must submit a performance bond for the faithful performance of the work contemplated (minimum \$3,000). This shall be a cash bond pass book bank account, bank letter of credit, or a bond issued by an approved security company licensed in the State of Connecticut. The bond shall be for the amount required by the Inspector and shall be enforced from January 1 to December 31 and shall cover any sewer project undertaken by the contractor until the expiration of the maintenance period for that project. The maintenance period shall be for the amount required by the Inspector (minimum 2 years). Must include description of work performed as follows:
"Connection to public sewer main at _____ in Wolcott, CT."

5. Contractor must provide Department with a connection date giving at least forty-eight working hours notice for an inspection. Inspections must be scheduled to be completed within normal business hours.

6. Contractor must notify Call Before You Dig.
7. Contractor must submit applicable permit fee (\$100 per).
8. Owner or Contractor must submit connection fee (\$2,500 p/unit).
9. No permit will be issued to or for any person who is delinquent to the Town of Wolcott for taxes, assessments, or usage fees. All accounts must be current or paid in full. A letter from the Tax Collector confirming all are paid in full is required. *Ref Ordinance #77.*

Make checks payable to Wolcott Sewer Department.

If any one of the above-listed requirements is not met, a permit absolutely will not be issued.
