# SCHEDULE OF ACTIVITIES

Monday, June 17, 2019 to Friday, July 26, 2019

**\*No Pre-Registration Required. Register and pay fees on first day.\***

All children registering for the summer playground activities will be charged a fee of \$45.00 per child per week, \$65.00 for two children per week, or a maximum of \$75.00 per immediate families per week. The program is offered to children entering kindergarten in September through those entering 6th grade in September. The playground will be open Monday through Friday at 9am and closed promptly at 3pm weather permitting. (See rain policy) Activities are designed for elementary school aged children. Action games played on playground site include nerf football, kickball, trench, volleyball, wiffleball, jump rope, relay races, etc. Arts and Crafts will also be taught.
