To the Wolcott Community:

Many of you have reached out seeking opportunities to help and volunteer as our community responds to the public health crisis. As the Town Administration, we are truly inspired by the kindness, generosity, and selflessness of our community. At this time, following the guidance of our local and state health officials and given the unique nature of this crisis, the best way for our community members to help is to make sure that they limit public interaction and exposure. If you are concerned for a friend, neighbor, or family member please call the Town Hall at 203-879-8100 so that we can connect this person or persons with assistance. As this crisis unfolds over the next few weeks we may find ourselves in need of volunteers to help with the community response.

For those of you who remain concerned, we would like to inform you of our current efforts to ensure the safety and well-being of our residents, in particular the vulnerable population:

- Effective Monday, March 16, 2020 at NOON, The Town Hall and the Town Hall Annex will be modifying operations to **appointment only** for essential services. **STAFF MEMBERS ARE AVAILABLE FOR ESSENTIAL SERVICES BY APPOINTMENT ONLY.** Please call the Department with which you need to do business. If your request is deemed essential and cannot be conducted electronically or rescheduled for a later date, a staff member will make an appointment for you. **Please contact the Town Hall at 203-879-8100 or for the Town Hall Annex, 203-879-8100 ext. 103.**
- The Wolcott Senior Center is currently closed to the public, but staff will be available to answer any questions. Should anyone need their assistance during normal business hours, Monday – Thursday 8-3:30 PM, Friday 8-12:30 PM, please call 203-879-8133. We have suspended the daily transportation service, but if an emergency arises, it will be dealt with on an individual basis. For more information on our Senior Bus, please call 203-879-2078. Should you call after hours, please leave a voicemail as we will be monitoring them regularly.
- For those in need of Food, you can contact the Food Pantry directly at 203-704-7402 or email them at [wolcottfoodpantry@yahoo.com](mailto:wolcottfoodpantry@yahoo.com).

- The Wolcott Public School System is offering free of charge meals to Wolcott residents age 18 years or younger. A parent or family member may pick up a lunch and a breakfast for each Wolcott child. These age and residency restrictions are in alignment with the federal program supporting this work. Children and parents/guardians can visit Frisbie Elementary School, **Monday through Friday. Between the hours of 11:30AM and 1:00PM to pick up grab-and-go meals.** The site will be set up as a “drive thru” location. **Please enter Frisbie from the Woodtick Road entrance, drive past the front of the school, and exit on the Todd Road side.**
- The Town’s Recycling Center will be closed indefinitely.

Please continue to monitor our Town website, [www.wolcottct.org](http://www.wolcottct.org) for any updated information. As you are aware, this situation is constantly changing and that is requiring our responses to change to keep up. We appreciate your patience and understanding at this trying time. We will do our utmost best to keep you abreast of any changes or mandates from our Government.
