MAYOR'S REPORT:

Mayor Dunn came forward and gave the following update:

- Last week's storm was very powerful; all of the emergency services and the Public Works Dept. were out and working together very productively
- Yesterday morning they started picking up brush
- The Public Work's Director job has been posted through the Council of Governments
- School is starting soon; hopefully everything goes well
- He received a letter from the Food Pantry requesting a generator so that their food doesn't spoil during the next power outage; they are looking into possible grants
- The Lions Club will have the food trucks this year instead of the fair; August 21-23

At this time, Mr. Masi stated that the Town of Wolcott is being embarrassed by all of the articles in the newspaper. He is approached regularly by townspeople wanting to know who runs the town. If this situation does not get resolved, he will be absent from the Town Council meetings.

Mayor Dunn replied that the Mayor is running the town operations, with the exception of the appointment of the ZEO. Everything else in town is running great. They have a 225-year celebration coming up in 2021. A committee has been put together and there will be more information to follow in the Wolcott Community News. The situation with Planning & Zoning and the ZEO is just a bump in the road for the Town.

Mayor Dunn noted that some Public Works employees had to help with some of the storm clean-up. Farmingbury's employees also did work. With regard to Mr. Kalinowski's health benefits, Mayor Dunn advised that a letter has been sent to him stating that he would not be receiving them anymore after August 31, 2020.

FINANCE OFFICER'S REPORT:

Susan Hale came forward and reported the following:

- For the current fiscal year, they have received 50% of their Town Aid Roads grant funds in the amount of \$151,000
- Last year they did not receive any Town Aid Roads grant funds until April
- She did not include the July financials in the packet since they were not completed before she was out of the office last week; they would have been the first set of financials with the new iVisions financial software and she wanted to verify them herself
- In September they will have the August financials
- For last fiscal year, they are focusing on finalizing and preparing for the audit which begins Monday, August 31st
- She submitted Year-End Transfers and one transfer for the current fiscal year; she submitted a revised Schedule A; there is only one change highlighted on the first page

Upon **MOTION** by Roger Picard, seconded by Joseph Membrino, it was voted by a majority to **table** 'Payment for Temporary Zoning Enforcement Officer' on the agenda, with Jason Stark opposing.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. **RESOLUTION: Commercial Property Assessed Clean Energy ("C-PACE") Agreement with Connecticut Green Bank**

Discussion ensued with regard to why this item is even on the agenda. Mayor Dunn stated that many other Towns have signed on to the program and there is a business in Town that would like to sign onto it. Mayor Dunn noted that a few years ago they opted out of the program. It was noted that there are liability issues and a good amount of administrative responsibilities involved including promoting the program to businesses in Town.

Attorney Tynan noted that this was first proposed in 2014 and never got off the ground because there were no requests from any businesses. He noted that Bartlett Construction is the interested party.

At this time, Chairman Valletta called Mr. Zuba on his cell phone. Mr. Zuba answered, at which time Chairman Valletta advised that the Council has a lot of questions regarding the program and the contract and that they can place this back on the agenda at a later date when Mr. Zuba can attend a meeting in person.

Mr. Zuba stated that he has concerns regarding the Coronavirus pandemic at this point. He stated that they would have to discuss the parameters as to how they would do this.

Chairman Valletta inquired what he meant by that.

Mr. Zuba stated that they would have to ensure that they were doing this in a very safe and sound manner and that everyone would be protected and that nothing would be harming anyone's health and safety.

Chairman Valletta stated that when Mr. Zuba feels he can travel here, they will place it back on the agenda. At this time, the call ended.

2. Discussion & Possible Action to Authorize Expenditure for Public Works Vehicle

Mayor Dunn came forward and referenced the specifications provided in the packet (**see attached**).

Discussion was held with respect to the current fleet of trucks, their condition, and maintenance programs, after which the following motion was made:

Upon **MOTION** by Domenic Angiolillo, seconded by Joseph Membrino, it was unanimously voted to **authorize** the expenditure for Public Works Vehicle {\$184,649.12 - Freightliner 114SD}.

3. Discussion with Planning & Zoning Commission

Chairman Valletta advised that they invited the Chairman to the meeting but nobody is here. He recommends that they call a Special Meeting for the purpose of holding a hearing to discuss Mr. Mahoney. Chairman Valletta advised that Mr. Picard and Mrs. Wisler had a meeting with Mr. Mahoney. Mr. Picard will give a brief overview as to what happened.

At this time, Mr. Picard passed out meeting notes and advised that on August 13th Mrs. Wisler arranged a meeting at her home with the Chairman of the Planning & Zoning Commission, Mr. Raymond Mahoney. He was also invited to attend and the meeting lasted about 1.5 hours. He next reviewed the notes from the meeting taken by Mrs. Wisler (**see attached**).

About halfway through, Mr. Stark and Mr. Membrino commented that the Council is receiving hearsay from an offsite meeting that was held with only two Council members present. Chairman Valletta asked that Mr. Picard continue. Mr. Picard continued reviewing the meeting notes. With regard to the Mayor's request to change the regulations regarding the hiring of a ZEO, Mr. Mahoney expressed that the best scenario would be for the Mayor to withdraw his request for a text change in the regulations.

Mr. Angiolillo made a motion to add an item to the agenda; there was no second.

The Council continued to discuss this issue, after which there was a consensus to schedule a **Special Meeting on Tuesday, August 25th at 7:00 p.m.** for the purpose of a hearing.

Attorney Tynan expressed that he feels this action is premature.

- Mr Cyr - Chairman and Vice Chair determined that part time evenings and weekends only would not work for Wolcott, They will submit name to rest of commissioners for discussion.
- Female applicant was researched by Chair and Vice-Chair and felt her resume did not fit in with their needs or criteria. Did not get recommendation from former employers. Will also submit her name and resume for discussion with balance of P&Z members
- Mr. Mahoney stated that he is willing to vet all applicants received from any source

Asked what criteria P&Z was looking for:

- Understanding prints
- Ability to read prints
- Knowledge of elevations
- Knowledge of traffic flow
- Must be a people person

P&Z at next meeting will discuss the possibility of hiring a Deputy ZEO, Person will work with current ZEO to ascertain their actual working knowledge. If OK will then be promoted to ZEO

Vice Chair willing to work with COG and CCM to get resumes and/or names for consideration.

RE text change requested by Mayor. Process by law is:

- Placed on Agenda
- Then have 65 days to schedule a Public Hearing
- Public Hearing could then be held 60 days later (not usually done so long after PH)
- P&Z then has 45 days to render a decision once the Public Hearing is closed

Chairman felt the best scenario would be to withdraw the request for text change

Payment:

- ZEO was legally hired by P&Z
- Work in June and July was properly performed
- Discussion within the P&Z committee approved the \$80.00 per hour fee
