As of May 19, 2021, Governor Lamont lifted restrictions on wearing a mask indoors for fully vaccinated people. **Non-vaccinated people must continue to wear a mask while in the senior center. Our center will be resuming our activities slowly, so we will continue to “zoom” our exercise classes for the month of June and start “in-person” classes beginning July 12. In addition to in-person classes, we will also “zoom” the classes for those seniors who wish to stay home.

Daily lunches from New Opportunities are on “hold” for now until we get a better idea of how many people are still interested in congregate lunches at the Senior Center. If any senior is interested in congregate lunches provided by New Opportunities, please call us at 203-879-8133. To qualify, you must be at least 60 years of age. The suggested donation for lunch is \$3.00.

We are continuing with weekly breakfasts and bi-monthly lunch specials giving a choice to “eat-in” or “drive through”. (Coffee will be served for “eat-in” only.) A **“BIG THANKS”** to all the seniors who have supported all our drive-through breakfasts & lunch specials! Our weekly drive through breakfasts have been averaging 45 sandwiches per week! The Mother’s Day breakfast special we served over 70 sandwiches! Our home-made meatball sub lunch special we served 63 subs! Our next breakfast special will be Father’s Day breakfast on Thursday, June 17. Call the center to order!

Our bus trips will resume in July and will adhere to capacity limits and mask-wearing pertaining to Covid-19 precautions per Chesprocott Health District. **Masks must be worn while riding the bus for vaccinated and non-vaccinated riders.** We will post all bus trips on our Senior Center information boards for all to sign up by the last week of June. SENIOR BUS—All riders MUST wear a mask while on the bus. Our Senior bus is currently operating M-F from 8:30 AM to 3:00 PM for doctor’s appointments, grocery shopping, and errands. Bus service will resume to full-time hours for July, operating from 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM with last pick up at 3:30 PM. To schedule bus service, call the bus line at 203-879-

2078 and leave your name, phone number, your address, and address where you wish to go, along with requested date and time for bus pick up. A minimum of 48 hours' notice is needed for scheduling bus service.

DIAL-A-RIDE BUS— All riders MUST wear a mask while on the bus. This bus service is available to Wolcott residents, 60+ years of age or handicapped individual on Fridays only. For a full description of service, go to The Town of Wolcott website www.wolcottct.org under Senior Center. Call the bus line at 203-879-2078 to reserve bus service. If you are currently not a participant, we will be happy to help you fill out an application.

COVID-19 VACCINE CLINICS—Our Senior Center has been designated as a vaccine site by Chesprocott, our Public Health Department. The Town of Wolcott website has information for people to sign up to get phone notifications for future vaccine clinics to be held at the senior center. Go to www.wolcottct.org and on the main page in the lower right corner you will see "TextMyGov". Use your mobile phone to text "Hi" to 203-404-6009. You will get a text message back that you have been signed up to receive notifications from The Town of Wolcott regarding the next vaccine clinic to be held at the Senior Center as well as other important notices. Our Wolcott website also has a direct link to the CT VAMS portal and instructions to follow. For more information regarding vaccine clinics, call our **Covid hotline at 203-718-5900** or call **Chesprocott at 203-272-2761** to check dates and availability at one of their clinics. Stop & Shop, Walgreens Pharmacy, CVS, and Rite Aid Pharmacies as well as Staywell Health Center, Wheeler Clinic, Walmart, Della Pietra Pharmacy, and Brass Mill Pharmacy have vaccine clinics in Waterbury & Wolcott. You must make an appointment for a vaccine through their websites. The United Way website at www.211ct.org has a listing of all vaccine sites available along with websites to make an appointment. SCAMS—Since the arrival of Covid-19 vaccines, scammers have used this as an opportunity to obtain sensitive information. An email that may appear to be coming from Pfizer or Moderna, is being sent to people asking them to take a survey in exchange for a reward. **THIS IS NOT A LEGITIMATE EMAIL! DO NOT OPEN EMAILS OR HIT LINKS UNLESS YOU KNOW AND TRUST THE SENDER! REMEMBER.... NEVER** give anyone your Social Security number, bank account information or credit card information that calls, emails, or knocks on your door!
